Besides these there are: One BINNEY Exhibition (\$50); Three STEVENSON Science Scholarships (\$50); One McCawley Hebrew Prize (\$50); One COGSWELL Scholarship (\$150), open for Candidates for Holy Orders; One McCawley Testimonial Scholarship (\$50); One AKINS Historical Prize (\$50); One ALMON-WELSFORD Testimonial (\$24); One HALIBURTON Prize (\$24); One COGSWELL Orleket prize. The necessary expenses of Board, Room, &c., average \$150 per annum. Nominated students do not pay tuition fees. These nominations fifty in number, are open to all Matriculated Students, and are worth about \$300 for the three years course.
