*The Secretary of State for External Affairs to the Chargé d'Affaires of Sweden  
in Canada*

SIR,

I have the honour to acknowledge your Note of May 16, 1958 in which you propose that there should be an amendment to the Agreement for Air Services between Sweden and Canada signed at Ottawa on June 27, 1947. <sup>(1)</sup>

The appropriate Canadian authorities concur in your suggestion that paragraph 2 of the Annex to the Agreement between Sweden and Canada be amended to read as follows:

"The route to be operated by the designated airline of the Government of Sweden shall be:—

Sweden via intermediate points in countries beyond—in both directions."

And that paragraph 4 of the Annex be amended to read as follows:

"The route to be operated by the designated airline of the Government of Canada shall be:—

Canada via intermediate points to Stockholm and to points in countries beyond—in both directions."

I confirm that your Note and this reply thereto shall constitute an Agreement between Canada and Sweden which shall take effect on this day, May 16, 1958. This Agreement shall be registered by the Canadian Government with the International Civil Aviation Organization in accordance with the terms of Article 7 of the Agreement between Canada and Sweden for Air Services signed at Ottawa on June 27, 1947.
