We will visit the Church of Los Angeles, Patron Saint of Costa Rica, being very venerated and respected by the Cosa Ricans. There will be a brief stop in the Ruins of the old Church of Cartago, which was obviously affected by earthquakes.

NT-HD-03 POAS VOLCANO

You will travel toward the northeast from San Jose, passing through the city of Alajuela, famous for its Central Park, called Park of the Mangos. On the road towards the volcano we will see coffee plantations, and flowers of different colors and diversity. Once you have reached the volcano, you will be able to see this marvelous colossus which has one of the widest active craters in the world, and every once in a while you may be surprised by a small eruption of steam and ash. You will also stroll on the trails of the park to see the intense green color of the landscape usually compared to those of Switzerland.

Besides you will be able to relax enjoying a period in the thermal waters. At night, Arenal Volcano may offer a marvelous spectacle with its lava sparks falling from the crater and the thunder of its eruption.

NT-AT-10 CABLE CAR

In a natural private reserve, besides Braulio Carrillo National Park, you can enjoy 90 minutes in the high canopy of the forest with its gardens of epiphytes, discovering plants and animals that are usually hidden up in the top of great trees.

When you arrive at the cable car you will receive a short introduction about the exploration of the canopy and the construction of the cable car. From that point you will begin a 45 to 50 minutes walk along one of the trails, accompanied by a nature guide. Following this, you will enjoy a marvelous trip on the cable car which has a total run of 2,600 meters whose highest point is 30 meters above the ground.

Duration: 7 hours, approximately
