- (ii) the Law on State Social Insurance, but only to the extent that it applies to pension insurance;
- (iii) the Law on Pension System Reform and the regulations made thereunder;
- (b) with respect to Canada:
 - (i) the *Old Age Security Act* and the regulations made thereunder;
 - (ii) the Canada Pension Plan and the regulations made thereunder.
- 2. Subject to paragraph 3, this Agreement shall also apply to laws and regulations which amend, supplement, consolidate or supersede the legislation specified in paragraph 1.
- 3. This Agreement shall further apply to laws and regulations which extend the legislation of a Party to new categories of beneficiaries or to new benefits unless an objection on the part of that Party has been communicated to the other Party not later than three months following the entry into force of such laws and regulations.

ARTICLE 3

Persons to Whom the Agreement Applies

This Agreement shall apply to any person who is or who has been subject to the legislation of the Republic of Lithuania or Canada, and to the dependants and survivors of such a person within the meaning of the applicable legislation of either Party.

ARTICLE 4

Equality of Treatment

Any person who is or has been subject to the legislation of a Party, and the dependants and survivors of such a person, shall be subject to the obligations of the legislation of the other Party and shall be eligible for the benefits of that legislation under the same conditions as citizens of the latter Party.
