The Department of External Affairs announced today that a meeting of the United Kingdom - Canada Continuing Committee on Trade and Economic Affairs is being held in London, England, Wednesday and Thursday, June 13 and 14.

This Committee which was established in 1948 meets from time to time to review the general economic situation and consider matters of common concern to the United Kingdom and Canada in trade and other economic affairs. The Committee meets alternately in London and Ottawa; the last meeting was held in Ottawa on December 8 and 9, 1955, with the United Kingdom High Commissioner, His Excellency Lieut-General Sir Archibald Nye as Chairman.

The Chairman for the current meeting is Mr. Norman A. Robertson, High Commissioner for Canada in the United Kingdom. Among other Canadian officials attending are:
