PIERRE DUPUY, WHOSE APPOINTMENT AS AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE WAS ANNOUNCED EARLIER, THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. MAYRAND'S SUCESSOR WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATES.

MR. SYDNEY PIERCE, WHO IS AT PRESENT DEPUTY HIGH COMMISSIONER TO THE UNITED KINGDON, HAS BEEN APPOINTED AMBASSADOR TO BELGIUM AND MINISTER TO LUXEMBOURG TO SUCCEED MR. CHARLES-PIERRE HEBERT WHOSE APPOINTMENT AS AMBASSADOR TO THE NETHERLANDS WAS ANNOUNCED EARLIER.
