His Excellency Nobuhiko Ushiba today presented his letter of Credence as Ambassador and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Canada.

The ceremony took place at Government House at 11:00 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis, presented the Ambassador to his Excellency the Governor General. Mr. G.P. de T. Glazebrook, Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, and Mr. Esmond Butler were in attendance on the Governor General on this occasion.

Mr. Ushiba was born in 1909. Since he entered the diplomatic service in 1932 he has served in Germany, Britain and Burma. Since 1957, he has been Director of Economic Affairs in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs at Tokyo.

Mr. Ushiba is married and has one daughter.
