

Mr. Hamilton (Qu'Appelle), seconded by Mr. O'Hurley, moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at its next sitting to consider the following proposed resolution which has been recommended to the House by His Excellency:

That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Northwest Territories Act to establish a Court of Appeal for the Northwest Territories; to authorize the Territorial Court of the Northwest Territories to sit in the Yukon Territory in civil matters; to provide for the appointment, remuneration and allowances of deputy judges of the Territorial Court; and to provide further for the general application of game legislation in the Northwest Territories.

Resolved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at its next sitting to consider the said proposed resolution.

The following Notice of Motion having been called was transferred to Government Orders for consideration at the next sitting of the House pursuant to Standing Order 21(2):

That a special committee be appointed to examine all expenditure of public monies for national defence and all commitments for expenditure for national defence since April 1st, 1958, as reported in Public Accounts, and to report from time to time their observations and opinions thereon, and in particular what, if any, economies consistent with the execution of the policy decided by the government may be effected therein, with power to send for persons, papers and records and to examine witnesses; and that in accordance with Standing Order 67, the committee shall consist of not more than fifteen (15) members to be designated by the House at a later date.—*The Minister of National Defence.*

The following Notice of Motion having been called was transferred to Government Orders for consideration at the next sitting of the House pursuant to Standing Order 21(2):

That a Special Committee, to be designated, be appointed to consider with Mr. Speaker the Procedure of this House for the purpose of suggesting any changes that may be desirable to assure the more expeditious dispatch of public business, with power to send for persons and papers, and to report from time to time its findings and recommendations to the House.—*The Prime Minister.*

The House resolved itself again into Committee of Supply.
