civil power may be withdrawn at such time and to such extent as the Chief of the Naval Staff or the Chief of the Air Staff, as the case may be, under the direction of the Minister, may order.

Province to pay expenses. **226.** All expenses and costs incurred by His Majesty 5 by reason of any of the Canadian Forces being called out under this Part in aid of the civil power, shall be paid to His Majesty by the province the Attorney General of which made the requisition requiring the Canadian Army to be called out.

Advances in first instance. **227.** Such moneys as are required to meet the expenses and costs occasioned by the calling out of the Canadian Forces as provided for in this Part and for the services rendered by them shall, pending payment by the province liable under section two hundred and twenty-six, be advanced in the first instance out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund by the authority of the Governor in Council, but shall be payable by and recoverable from the province to and by His Majesty as moneys paid by His Majesty to and for the use of the province at the request of the province.
