The only comment I would make to that is I think the problem is going to be one that almost requires a committee to keep up with the various factors being introduced almost as you go through the legislation. This is really the kind of problem that we have brought to you today. We hoped we could have a discussion with you. I feel we have had a very healthy discussion and I have enjoyed it. I hope you have enjoyed it. We would be very pleased at any time to come back for further discussion on this project or any other subject that might be of interest to the Commission.

The Vice-Chairman Mr. McLeavey: do you still have a question?

Mr. McLeavey: Since time is short, I will direct a four-word question to Mr. Mark...

Mr. Mark: I did not complete what I stated or have not given a full picture. We talked about the popular records being given to stations in order to promote recording stars some of whom do not stay as long very long but there are more stations and other types of music than any time, what we call the contemporary or the new popular music today. However, these records are not being sold and one member has commented to me that his cost is about \$400 per month for a smaller market or medium-sized market in records alone. In our particular Commission which is a combined AM-FM-TV we are spending more like \$1,500 per month for records because we do not see as many of the popular recording stars as what we call a rock or contemporary station would play.

...I cannot put percentages on it, but I hope that that might clarify part of the question that earlier.

All right if you have no more questions I would not want to put a repetition for long windows, Mr. Chairman you are correct.

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
