- 2 March 16—That he will inquire of the Government if it is true, as reported in the public press, that the Canadian High Commissioner in London has been sent to Berlin in connection with the lapsing, in July next, of the Anglo-German treaty of Commerce, and what is the nature of his instructions?

Also, whether it is the intention of the Government to send Lord Strathcona to Belgium, France and other European countries for the same object?
