Lest I should be accused of being merely obstructive, may I ask if there is any reason why Greek 1 should not be held at 11 on M.W.F., and German 1 on Tu.,Th.,Sat., leaving History 1 at the old hour? Greek 1 and German 1 are both much smaller classes than History 1, and it is unlikely that anyone anxious to take Greek 1 will also want to take both Physics and Chemistry.
