Devon, or Ayrshire, or Holstein, may be selected according to the views of the farmer in regard to Dairy produce. Each breed has its special merits, but those that are best for milk are usually least adapted for beef.

FEBRUARY is a trying month for cattle. We cannot too strongly impress the necessity of care in their feeding, watering, and general treatment, at this season of the year. When they once begin to fall off, it is up-hill work to attempt to stop it. Barns may be faulty, and the cold is severely felt, the root cellar may be troublesome to get at, and the animals miss an occasional meal; the wells may be frozen and the way to watering places may be so slippery that the cattle cannot reach them without discomfort or positive accident. In order to overcome these and many other difficulties that appear in February, it is a good rule to give extra time and attention to the stock. In feeding grain and meal always mix them into cut hay, moistened, otherwise they do not undergo the second mastication, but
