THIS SCHOOL was founded about thirty years ago in Victoria, for the purpose of providing a sound training, mental and physical, on the lines of the great Public Schools of England. Careful religious instruction is included in the curriculum, unless parents express any definite wish to the contrary.

The Religious Instruction is based on the principles of the Bible. The boarders attend the Anglican Church, but they may at their parents' or guardians' wish attend any place of worship to which they may be accustomed.

Day scholars are required to conform in every respect to the regulations laid down.

Particular stress is laid on the fact that a competent staff of masters will always be maintained sufficient to ensure adequate individual attention being paid to each pupil. In accordance with this plan careful tuition is thus given to backward boys.

There is a well-equipped Gymnasium in which classes are held by a competent teacher once a week for senior and junior boys.

Recent successes include Entrance Examinations for the English Public Schools ; Trinity College; Port Hope; the Navy ; McGill University Matriculation ; Preliminary Law ; Preliminary Surveyors' Examinations.
