

sible that such a bed might be discovered which would be rich enough to pay for working, or failing this a bed might be discovered and identified which could be assisted to fall into the river, to be there assorted and concentrated, with the purpose of quickly enriching the bars for the miners.

The supply of gold to be obtained from the sandstones which form the banks of the Saskatchewan valley is unlimited, but nature is drawing on this supply very slowly. It is quite possible, however, that nature could be easily assisted in procuring the gold from these sandstones to the great benefit of the mining industry of the Province of Alberta
