

2. Ordinary Members shall consist of Graduates and Undergraduates in the Honor Course in Natural Sciences.

3. Life Members shall consist of such Ordinary Members as shall have paid four years' membership fees to the funds of the Association.

4. Corresponding Members shall consist of such Graduates in Natural Science, not resident in Toronto, as may be desirous of contributing to the objects of the Association.

5. Honorary Members shall consist of (1) all Ex-Presidents of the Association; (2) such gentlemen as shall be elected by a vote of five-sixths of the members present at any regular meeting of the Association.

6. Candidates for membership shall be nominated at a regular meeting preceeding their election.

7. Names of all Candidates for Membership shall be posted up in the Entrance Hall at least one week before their election, and any member may, by private notification to the President, require that a ballot be taken for the election of such candidates.

8. In case no ballot be demanded before the next regular meeting of the Association, the President shall announce at such meeting the names of the candidates proposed, and declare them duly elected. In case a ballot is demanded, the President shall announce the same without disclosing the name of the member who requested it; the ballot shall be taken in the usual manner, and the votes of five-sixths of the members present shall be necessary for the election of such candidate.
