And a Motion being made, and Question put, That the Right Honourable the Lord Mayor be defired to iffue a Precept, to affemble the Livery, in Common Hall, pursuant to their Application to his Lordship? The same was declared to be carried in the Negative; and a Division being demanded and granted, there appeared to be six Aldermen and Eighty-sour Commoners, besides the two Tellers, for the Negative; and three Aldermen and Sixty-seven Commoners, besides the two Tellers, for the Affirmative; whereupon his Lordship declared the same to be carried in the Negative.
