doubt and deliberation. I am not fure the Americans do not think, that when they afk for bread it is giving them a SERPENT: I know it is the opinion of fome French, and many more Americans. I do not speak at random; I have heard and seen opinions of great weight on that head: One I will name to you, Monsieur du Portail, a man of rank and character; and as they are very strong and very apposite, I will quote to you some lines out of as sensible a letter as I ever read; it is a setter from that gentleman to Monsieur de St. Germain, at that time Minister of the War department in France, written above an year ago. His words are:

"It may be asked, whether it would not be better to send a body of twelve or fifteen thousand men hither, Ce servit le vrai moyen de tout gâter. That would be the true way to spoil all. These people here, though at war with the English, hate the French much more than the English; and notwithstanding all that France has done, or might do for them, they would prefer a reconciliation with their
