

Lord Jesus Christ,<sup>1</sup> and that His willing sacrifice<sup>2</sup> upon the cross was the one propitiation and atonement for the sins of the whole world, wherein God hath declared His righteousness, that He might be just, and the justifier of him that believeth in Jesus.<sup>3</sup> He is the Lamb of God, without blemish and without spot, with whose precious blood we are redeemed.<sup>4</sup> The remission of sins which any partake of is only in and by virtue of that most satisfactory sacrifice, and no otherwise.<sup>5</sup>

We reverently confess and believe that divine honor and worship are due to the Son of God,<sup>6</sup> and that He is in true faith to be prayed unto, and the name of the Lord Jesus Christ called upon, as the primitive Christians did,<sup>7</sup> and that we cannot acceptably offer up prayers or praises to God, nor receive a gracious answer or blessing from Him, but in and through His dear Son.<sup>8</sup>

#### THE HOLY SPIRIT.

We believe that the Holy Ghost is, in the unity of the Eternal Godhead, one with the Father and the Son;<sup>9</sup> that He is the promise of the Father,<sup>10</sup> whom Christ declared He would send in His name;<sup>11</sup> that He is come and convicts the world of sin; that He leads to repent-
