Kamloops, B.C., early in January.

Immediately on its arrival track lay-

completed. There are no less than nine

steel bridges under construction

on the line between Yale, B.C., and

Kamloops. Tracklaying will also be

carried out between Hope, B.C., and

Kamloops. Six thousand tons of

steel in the Port Mann yards, and

additional cargoes of 6000 tons each at

Port Mann in March and April next.
