Chicago, Sept. 13.—Curtis Brown writes to The Record-Herald from London as follows:

Farming doesn't pay well in England, as a rule, but there is one man who makes, as nearly as can be estimated, \$200,000 a year out of it, and has taken \$500,000 worth of cash and cups as his reward.

Farmer.
