## FIVE THOUSAND CHINESE ATTEND SCHOOL IN JAPAN

Chinese Missionary Deplures Fact That U. S. Laws Prevent Them From Studying There.

A stirring appeal for the intervention and aid of the Christian Church in Canada was made by Rev. Mr. Lunde of the American Mission Church in Hoon, China. A great awakening was in progress in the Chinese empire. Never before and never again would such a favorable opportunity present itself for the spread of the gospel. At the present time they were in a receptive mood. With the assistance of the American missionaries, the building of modern temples and other edifices of war, there was a clamor that the Chinese would pass beyond this period. With increased prosperity and prestige, the Chinese inclination to live with modern American institutions and the doctrine of Christ. At the present time 500 of the youth of China were learning the arts of war and imbibing the ideas of the Japanese universities. The proper treatment of the Chinese nation by the United States these young men would have been acquiring this instruction in American schools.
