**Clause in the Act Affects Workers for

The clause stipulates that "no person employed or paid by a candidate to act as a scrutineer or for any other purpose in connection with a municipal election, shall be entitled to vote at such election."

This may mean that friends of the candidates who have hitherto been in the habit of working at elections will hereafter refuse to do so, rather than lose their votes.
