To the Editor of The Times-Star: Sir,-I was very much interested to read in this morning's Telegraph-Journal the news that the City Coun cil at its meeting yesterday afternoon an amendment to the City Charter Act to do away with the double election for commissioners and Mayor, so that if possible this coming April there would be only one election instead of two as during some years past. I notice that several of the commissioners at the council meeting advocated this course on the ground that it would save the city considerable expense. I was also delighted to see recently that Mr. E. A. Schofield, the former Mayor, was advocating a change in the present city assessment and taxation system, proposing especially provis-ion for the payment of city taxes by mstallments.

May I be permitted to call your at
