Daily Hints For the Cook

SPONGE CAKE

Beat the whites of five eggs until quite stiff, 1 cup sugar. When beating eggs add sugar a little at a time. Then beat the yolks until light and add them to the white. Add to the eggs one cup of flour folded in, but do not stir it in.

BANANA SOUFFLE

Boil milk, add cornstarch, 5 table-spoons to a quart of milk dissolved first in a little cold milk. Be sure your milk boils before adding cornstarch, add yolks of 2 eggs beaten with powdered sugar. Slice bananas, but don't peel till ready to use, as they get black. Now beat the 2 whites of eggs very stiff, add a little powdered sugar and mix with the rest.
