DARING RESCUE OF WOMAN TRAPPED IN BURNING BUILDING

Silent Crowd Tensely Excited as Chauffeur Climbed Up Wall.

New York, May 19.—With daring that had a crowd in the street breathless with fear and excitement, two firemen and a civilian rescued a woman from the flames of a burning building. The woman, Mrs. Cecelia Reder, stood poised in the window of her room on the top floor of the rooming house, 104 West Forty-fifth street. Her husband, who had been in the building, had been struck by a falling beam and was unable to reach her. The fire had broken out in the kitchen, and the flames had spread rapidly. The firemen, who were on the scene within a few minutes, saw that the woman was in danger. One of them, a fireman named [name], climbed up the wall of the building and reached the window. He saw the woman and called to her. She came to the window and he helped her down. The fire was extinguished before it got beyond the third floor.
