all Quarterly Meetings, in addition to those on the schedules prepared for District Meetings and Conference:—"Do the Officials use intoxicating drinks as a beverage?" "How many Temperance Meetings have you held the past year?"—Also, all candidates for the Local Preachers' Plan to be asked, "Are you a total abstainer from all intoxicating drinks?" The answer must be in the affirmative, if the party be received.

17. That we recommend the formation of Temperance Societies in all our Churches.

18. That at the commencement of next Conference a Committee on Finance and Statistics be selected, in order to ascertain to what extent we may enlarge our Mission work and pecuniary liabilities.

19. That the name of Darlington Circuit be changed to that of "Bowmanville Circuit."

20. That Bro. R. Boyle attend the Kingston Camp Meeting as desired; and that the arrangements relative to Toronto District Camp Meeting be confirmed.

21. That Messrs. George Lamb, John George Eriskin, and Osmond be our Delegates in the English Conference.
