UNEMPLOYMENT RETURNS.

Very little change in the employ nest situation throughout Canada is shown by the bulletin of the Employment Service, covering the two partmental index number, covering reports from 5,400 business firms, od at 89.9 as compared with 90.2 for the preceding two weeks, and with 107.5 for the corresponding period of 1920. Employment continues at about the level of the middle of Jansary last, when the index number stood at 90.4, the highest point ached in the present year. easonal expansion in logging con-inued during the fortnight under re-tiew, but this was offset by a shrink-inge in saw milling operations. The situation in the prairie provinces was somewhat more favorable than in other parts of Canada, largely, says the bulletin, on account of expansion in milway construction.
