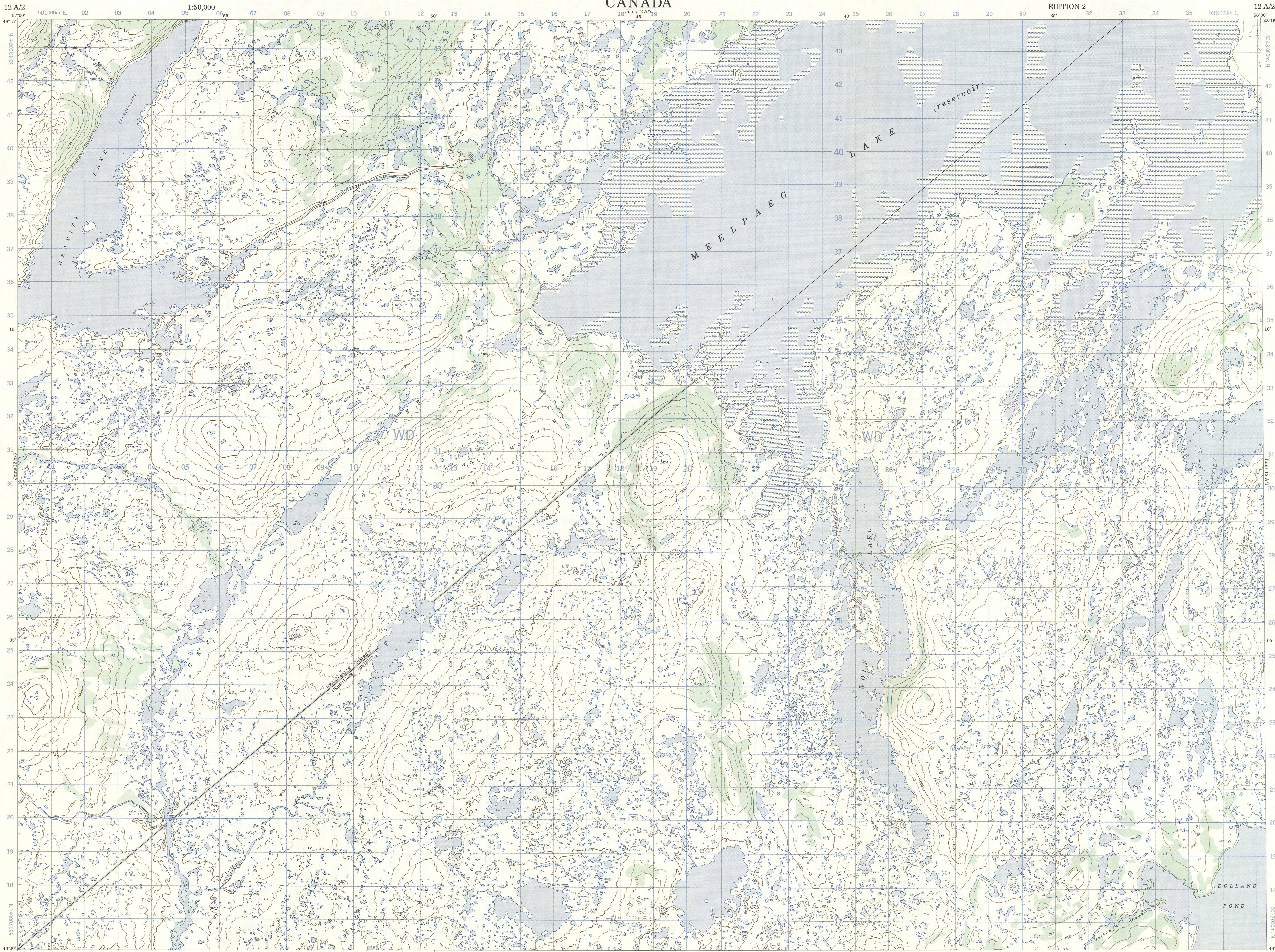

TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE LINES
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP

REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (as above)

EASTING: Read number on grid line
immediately to left of point
Estimated height of square from
this line westward to point

NORTHING: Read number on grid line
immediately below point
Estimated height of square from
this line northward to point

EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 975984
Nearest similar grid reference 350,000 metres (about 13 miles)
