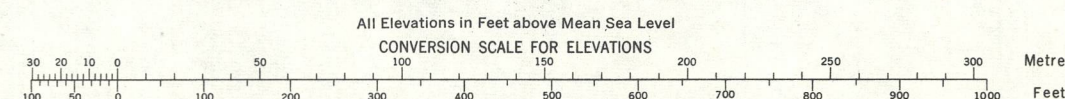
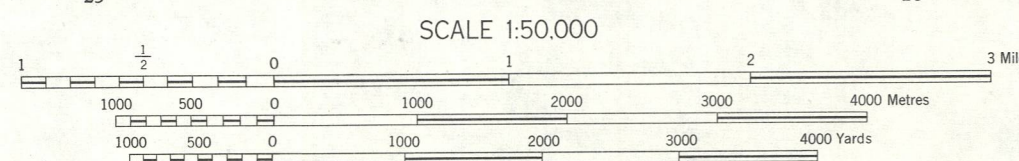
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 15°29' EAST,
