Alderman Groose of Moncton and Mr. Ryan Nominated Saturday.

Speeches by Hon. H. R. Emmerson, J. D. Hazen and Several Others.

MONCTON, N. B., Sept. 30.-Yesterday's nomination day in Albert county attracted a large number of the electors of the county assembled at the Court House at Hopewell Cape to listen to the nomination speeches. Mr. Ryan of Coverdale, the nominee of the Liberal party, addressed a few words to the electors, asking them to elect him as he was a government supporter, while Mr. Groose, being in opposition, could do nothing for them.

Hon. H. R. Emmerson then took the platform and after delivering what he called his valedictory to the electors of Albert and reviewing his acts during his representation of the county at Fredericton, attempted to defend the government from Mr. Jonah's criticism, speaking for an hour.

Mr. Emmerson spoke for an hour in reply in a vain and labored attempt to meet the case put by Mr. Hazen, and at the conclusion of his speech, although nearly six o'clock, there were loud cries for Hazen, in response to which that gentleman again came to the front and delivered a short but spirited speech, showing the recklessness of the statements made by the ex-premier and his inability to meet the charges made.

Mr. Emmerson then attempted to speak and appealed to the crowd to hear him, which he declined to do and left the court house.

The audience was a very orderly one and gave the closest attention to the discussion between the ex-premier and the opposition leader, and the conservatives are jubilant over the result.
