OFFICERS TELLS FATE
OF THE KARLSRUHE

San Juan, Puerto Rico, April 28—Wat is believed to be authentic information of the fate of the German cruizer Karlsruhe, which was active in the waters of the Caribbean and off the coast of Brazil during the first months of the war, was given this week by Captain Heinrich Lubinus, at e officer on the Karlsruhe, and who brought the German prize K. D. III. formerly was the British freighter Farne, and was captured October 5, 1914.
