B. at Buckfastleigh, Devonshire, Eng., 25 Nov., 1820. M., April 1846, Jane, dau. of Mr. John Easterbrook, of Jordan, Widecomb-in-the-Mow, Devonshire. Is a farmer. Has been Deputy Reeve and Reeve of North Dorchester, and Warden of Middlesex. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g.e. 1871 and sat until g.e. 1883, when he was not a candidate. Re-elected at last g.e.
