

Reeve and Reeve of Strathroy, Warden of the Co. of Middlesex in 1883 and a Trustee of the Strathroy High Sch. Board from 1873. First returned to Parl. 14 Dec. 1883 on the sitting mem., Mr. G. W. Ross being unseated. A Liberal. *Strathroy.*

CAMERON, HECTOR, M. A., Q. C. (*North Victoria*.)

Descended from the Glen Dessery branch of the Clan Cameron, of Inverness-shire, Scot. Only surviving s. of the late Asst. Commissary Genl. Kenneth Cameron; and nephew of the late John Cameron, Esq., who represented Victoria in Can. Assem. from 1857 to 1861. B. in Montreal, 3 June 1832. Educated at King's Coll., London, Eng., and at Trinity Coll., Dublin, where he graduated B.A. 1851. Afterwards took degree of M.A. at Univ. of Toronto, M., Aug. 1860, Clara, eldest dau. of William Boswell, Esq. Barrister at Law; and grand-dau. of Capt. Hon. W. Boswell, R.N. Called to the Bar, Ont., Easter Term 1854. Apptd. a Q.C. 1872, and is a Bencher of the Law Soc. of Ont. Unsuccessfully contested South Victoria at g.e. 1867, and North Victoria at g.e. 1874, both for the Commons. Was again a candidate for latter seat 10 Nov. 1874, on the sitting mem. (Mr. MacLennan) being unseated, when the latter was returned, but being again unseated 4 May 1875, Mr. Cameron was declared the sitting mem. on a scrutiny of votes. Re-elected at g.e. 1878, again at last g.e.—*Toronto; Toronto Club; Rideau Club.*

CAMERON, HUGH, M. D., J. P. (*Inverness*.)

Family came from Fort William, Inverness-shire, Scot. B. in the Co. of Antigonish, N.S., 18 March 1836. M., Nov. 1863, Eunice, fourth dau. of Hon. John McKinnon, M. L. C., Antigonish. Graduated M. D. at Univ. of Philadelphia, March, 1861, and at the School of Practical Obstetrics, same city, Aug., 1861. Represented Inverness in the Commons from g.e. 1867, until 1872. Sat in the L.C., N.S., from March 1879 to May, 1882, when he resigned. Re-elected to the Commons at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative, and favorable to the National Policy.—*Marion N.S.*
