

XV. And be it enacted, That if any action Limitation of actions.  
 or suit shall be brought against any person  
 or persons for any matter or thing done in  
 pursuance of this Act, such action or suit  
 5 shall be brought within six calendar months  
 next afterwards; and the Defendant or De-  
 fendants in such action or suit may plead the  
 general issue only, and give this Act and the  
 special matter in evidence on the trial.

10 XVI. And be it enacted, that if the said Bridge to be constructed within five years.  
 bridge shall not be constructed and used  
 within three years from the passing of this Act,  
 then the said Corporation and the privileges  
 hereby conferred upon it, shall from thence-  
 15 forth cease and determine.

XVII. And be it enacted, That this Act Public Act.  
 shall be deemed and taken to be a Public Act,  
 and as such shall be judicially noticed by all  
 Judges, Justices of the Peace and other per-  
 20 sons without being specially pleaded.

XVIII. And be it enacted, That notwith- Legislature may at any time alter the provisions of this Act.  
 standing the privileges hereby conferred, the  
 Legislature may at any time hereafter make  
 such addition to this Act or such alterations  
 25 of any of its provisions as they may think  
 proper for affording just protection to the  
 public, or to any person or persons, body  
 politic or corporate in respect, to their estate,  
 property or rights or any interest therein, or  
 30 any advantage, privilege or convenience con-  
 nected therewith, or in respect to any way or  
 right, public or private, that may be affected  
 by any of the powers given by this Act.
