

Northland board dissolved

A comprehensive study which concluded that the Northland School Division #61 "is not satisfactorily meeting the needs of the majority of students enrolled in its schools" has prompted Education Minister David King to dissolve the board and name an official trustee.

King made the announcement when he released the report of the Northland School Division Investigation Committee today in Peace River.

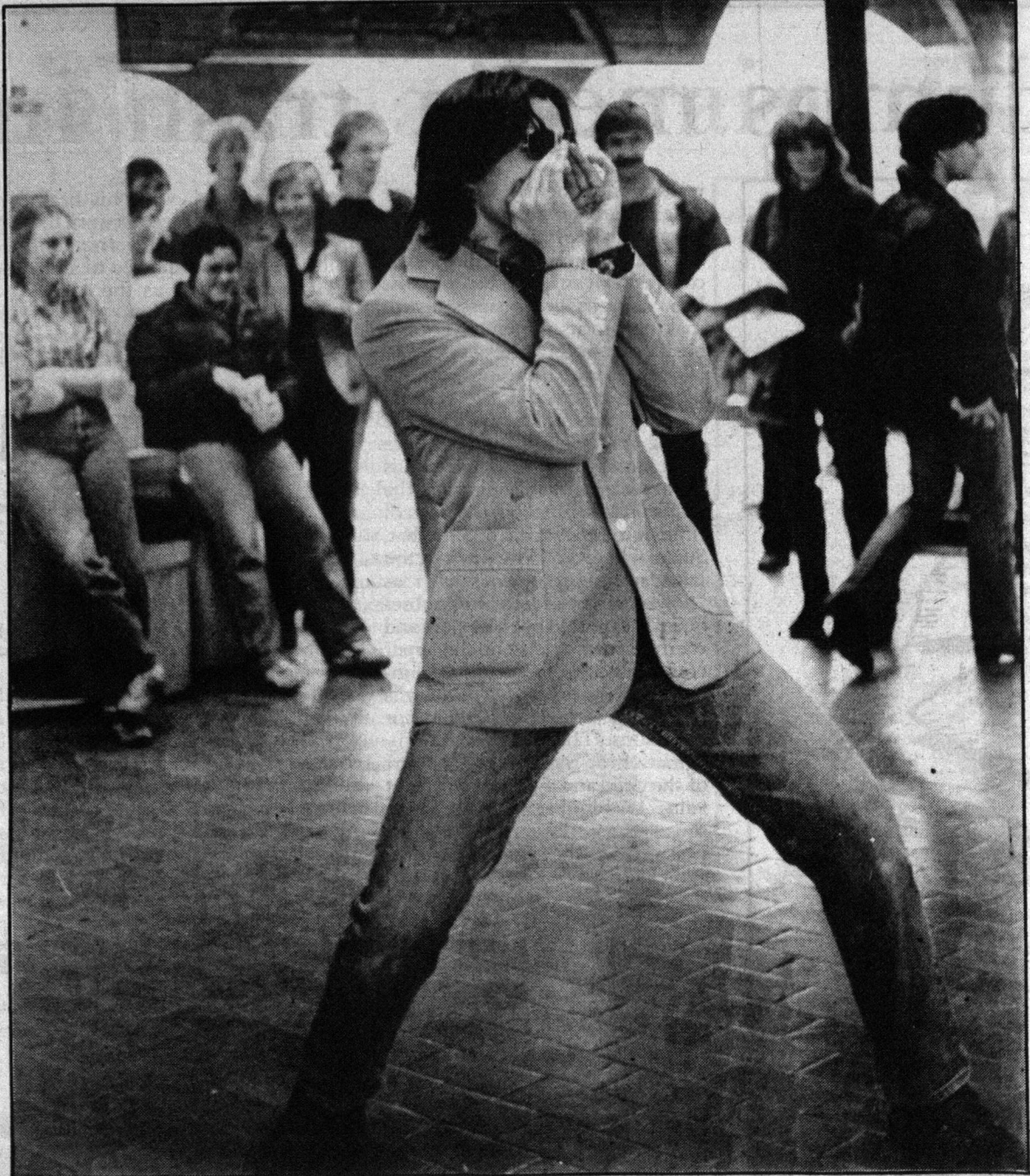
The current board is appointed by the Minister of Education. The Executive Council will be terminating their appointments.

For a two year term the official trustee, Fred J. Dumont, will assume responsibility for governing education affecting 27 elementary and secondary schools

in northern Alberta.

"In 1960 when the Northland School Division was established, it had a unique policy-making structure. It was innovative and encouraged development within the Division. Today, that is no longer so. In fact, the structure is now responsible for many serious problems.

"We owe it to the people of Northland to re-organize the structure. In the north where schools are often isolated and education is extremely complex - solutions do not come easily. A greater degree of self-government is needed. The challenge is to discover whether a structure identical to those in the rest of the province will work or whether we need a unique form of self-government for the north," says King.

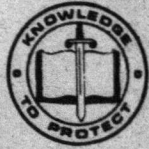
