Grant in aid of the Four Hundredth Anniversary Celebration of the Landing of Jacques Cartier and to assist celebrations at Gaspe, Three Rivers, Ottawa and Niagara, to be disbursed under direction of the Treasury Board \$100,000

Tercenary Committee of Three Rivers to assist the celebration in commemoration of the founding of that City 28,000
