With reference to your letter of the 14th April regarding the work which you performed in obtaining information regarding the number of Indians within your district who ~~are~~ are affected with tuberculosis, I beg to say that you may submit an account for any disbursements which you made while engaged in this connection. The account should be supported by receipts, if possible, and it should be certified to the effect that the charges therein contained were incurred while on Government business. I may add that it will not be possible for the Department to make ^{you} an allowance for the number of miles travelled while obtaining information.
