Referring to your letter of the 13th instant, No. 254038-44A,  
I beg to advise you that Mr. J. D. MacKenzie has been instructed  
regarding the terms thereof.

In order to prevent any future misunderstanding, however,  
I would state that as it is necessary to procure the canoes and  
equipment for the men from our LacSeul Post, the period of hire  
will commence from the time they leave Lac Seul until the time  
they are returned, arrangements being made that they shall be  
available at Hudson on the morning of the 14th of June.
