With Cheque.


Ottawa, 9th January, 1903.

Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd ultimo enclosing voucher No. 861 amounting to \$516.32 for beef supplied your Agency by Indians, and in reply I beg to inform you that \$22.00 of the amount of this voucher has been placed to the credit of the Bull Fund; \$125.72 has been credited to the Ranch Fund, while I enclose herewith in your favor cheque No. 3055 for \$368.60 (the balance of the amount of the voucher) in order that you may pay the Indians in question.

Kindly obtain the Indians' receipts in duplicate, one set of which you should forward with your cash-book return. The cheque number should be written on the receipts, also on the cash-book return opposite the amount of the cheque.
