

for the sexes. A hot bath has been provided in each of the lavatories for patients, and a shower bath and dressing for each in the basement.

Fresh air and sleeping accommodation has been provided also by the dormitories, and verandahs on the ground floor. Special provision for the convalescents is provided in the basement. You will note that recreation rooms have been provided for each sex in the basement. The dining-room, however, like the classroom, is common to both sexes. The kitchen, store-room and pantries are arranged in a simple and satisfactory arrangement and will be made in the plans and specifications for heating and ventilation.

I am of the opinion that the plans will meet with your approval, as while not following the plans submitted for the building we have endeavoured to fully provide all of the accommodation which you think necessary in a building of this class. I will be glad to have your criticism and approbation at an early date, as providing the plans are favourably considered, we hope to have tenders taken on the building within a few weeks from this time.
