

While Canada has made vast strides towards recovery in

past 22 years, two factos, beyond control

of Government - drought and recession abroad
have had detrimental effect upon Canadian
economy -

<u>Drought</u> - brought drastic reduction in exportable surplus of grain, cattle and other farm products -

only bus. as compared
with yearly average of bus.

over past 15 years;

Conditions abroad - effects most clearly seen in Canada's export trade with U.S. which, in first 6 months of 1938 showed % drop over corresponding period of 1937;

Prospects now brighter:

good wheat crop expected - while price of wheat
has fallen, the money returns from sales
will be well distributed throughout west consequent effects upon relief expenditures, and
upon milways, shipping, banking, and
