Cross Exam:

I don't know what time Lee was in. Lee told me they came home in the convoy. They were waiting for it. I didn't see Lee get in a truck. There were 6 or 8 trucks in the convoy. They were about 20 yards apart. I stopped only long enough to light a cigarette.

By the Court:

There are several ways to come to the camp. There were people in front of me.

The closing address of the Prosecutor:

Davidson's evidence should be accepted. If it is the accused is guilty.
