

ARTICLE 8.—AMENDMENTS

The Constitution or By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the delegates at any annual Convention, provided notice of the proposed amendments shall be mailed to the Secretary at least three months prior to the Convention, and that notice of such amendment shall be incorporated in the Official Call.

BY-LAWS

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section 1. The Executive Committee shall consist of eight members. The Executive Committee shall act for the Association between Conventions, shall have power to initiate plans and meet emergencies, and shall report to the convention on the opening day of each session through the Permanent Secretary. The President and Vice-Presidents shall be ex-officio members of the Executive Committee.

Section 2. The Executive Committee shall annually appoint a Local Secretary and Treasurer who shall be residents of the city or town chosen for the following year's Convention. The duties of the Local Secretary Treasurer shall be the handling of arrangements and funds in connection with the forthcoming convention.

CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

A Committee on Credentials consisting of three members shall be appointed by the Executive Committee at least ten days prior to each Convention. The Permanent Secretary shall be ex-officio a member of the Committee on Credentials. The duty of the Committee shall be:
