


Fig. 5. *Artemiopsis stefansoni* (Johansen). Male, 7-10 mm. long. Cotypes. Bernard harbour, N.W.T., October 6, 1915. About  $\times 50$ .



the nine joints of the tail (abdomen) very similar to those of *A. bungei*; the cereopods are with both sexes less slender at their base than in other species of fairy-shrimps and more in the shape of continuations of the two "halves" of the last abdominal segment (see figs. 5b, c, 6d). The head of the male (fig. 5a, e) is
