

This crate is 8 feet long, 3 feet 6 inches wide, and 16 inches high. The floor is 1×4 -inch material; corner pieces of 2×2 -inch, while the slats are of 2-inch cedar strips. The crate is divided in the centre by a solid board partition.

Plenty of disinfectant should also be available on each farm or poultry-ranch where the culling is done.
