Duties of the Board of Management and Officers.

—The Institution is open to boys of the ages mentioned in 2nd Rule of the Regulations, the claims for admission being the utter friendlessness of the applicant, or being a child of drunken and dissolute parents; the object of this Institution being the prevention of juvenile crime, by training these poor outcasts in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
