BANK HOLIDAYS IN ONTARIO.

Sundaya, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Easter fonday, The Queen's Birthday, Dominion Day, and each day appointed by Royal reclamation as a General Fast or Thanksgiving Day.

TO SKELETONIZE LEAVES.

Select well-grown leaves, and examine carefully to see if they are perfect store soaking. Put into an earthenware dish or wooden tub, keep covered with un-water and stand in the sun. In from two to three weeks' time the skin in the shy part—epidermis and parenchyma—will be found to be pulpy and cayed. Provide yourself with some cards as large, or larger, than any of a leaves, a soft camel's hair brush, as well as one a little stiffer. Gently at a leaf on to a card, and with the soft brush carefully remove the skin on one ds. Have ready a pan of clear water, reverse the card in the water and slip it ider the leaf so that the other side is uppermost. Brush this to remove the skin, ben most of the parenchyma, or fleshy part, will come with it, but if not it may merally be washed out in the water. If this soft brush fails to remove all the ren particles adhering to the framework, the hard brush may be used, but with rat care. Any brushing action or horizontal motion will surely break the veins, at the use of the stiff brush can only be successful in a perpendicular direction—soft of gentle tapping—to loosen the tissue so that it may be washed out with soft brush.
