This set being edited by Danby Pickering, and is from the Library of the Late SIR JOHN A. MACDONALD, whose bookplate will be found in nearly every volume. A portion of the Reign of King George III. being 4to. The 25th Session is not quite complete, OTHERWISE IS A SUBSTANTIAL OLD SET.
