

THE MIND OF THE CHURCH

Professor Bertram Windle, K. S. G., one of the most distinguished university principals in Ireland, contributes to the Catholic Truth library a brochure entitled "The Intellectual Claims of the Catholic Church," one of the greatest facts that history has known, as he puts it. The article, which first made its appearance in the form of an address in Dublin, is devoted to showing up the fallacy that the Catholic Church is solely a Church whose appeal is made to the heart, and that it takes no account of intellectual needs of its followers. "We forget," says Dr. Windle, "or, perhaps, we have never known, that the Church has been the mother, and in many cases the fondly loved mother, of more great writers and of more great discoveries in all branches of discovery, than have all the other religions of the world put together."
